



CAMPFIRE FILM FESTIVAL AWARDS SHORT FILM SUBMISSION

Campfire is designed for short films which generate stimulating and constructive discussion about matters of spirituality, meaning and faith. A film will be considered for the Campfire Film Festival Awards if it meets the following general criteria:

1. It is of 10 minutes 59 seconds duration or less
2. It promotes constructive discussion about faith, spirituality or ideology
3. It does not incite violence or hatred towards any religion or faith

The Campfire Film Festival offers an innovative hybrid model of live and online exhibition.

These are similar in principle to general video hosting sites like YouTube, and includes the understanding of your obligation to have cleared all rights to music, actors and images for online exhibition.

The benefits of online exhibition is immediate exposure to a world-wide audience.

In addition, Campfire offers site visitors the option of downloading a high and low resolution version of your film for viewing offline – but only if you allow it.

In its current transitional phase, Campfire is offering free entry for short films to be judged by its independent panel during September 2009. There will be no expectation to host your film on our website if your film is not shortlisted.

However, if your film is selected as one of the 8 finalists screened live on November 29, you hereby agree to become part of the new website that is planned to be launched during 2010, which offers filmmakers financial return online for their film(s) if downloaded (ie. viewers pay per high-res download).

Your film will NOT go online until the new website is launched. You will be notified of these details closer to the launch of the new website.

Irrespective of online hosting, your film must meet standard film festival requirements, where you agree that it your obligation to have cleared all rights to music, actors and images for public exhibition.
